North Pointe will honor Veterans with a special ceremony in the Nest on Monday, November 10th, at 8:30 am.

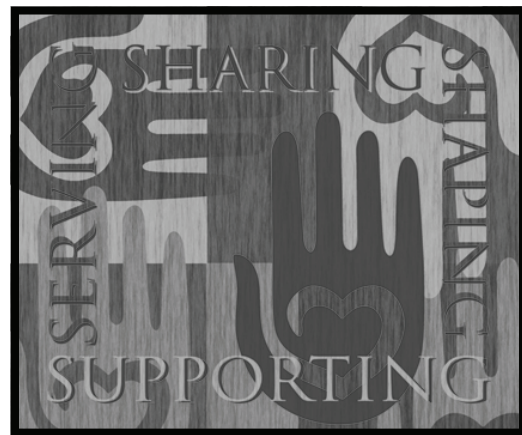
The half-hour tribute will feature a video montage, student reflections and a guest speaker.
